Skeet Fields Closed: The skeet fields will be closed for a special ZOMBIE rifle/pistol shoot on October 31. In addition, to allow the rifle shooters a couple of November weekend dates to shoot from 200 yards, the fields will also be closed Sunday the 8th and Saturday the 14th.

Halloween Rifle Shoot: A special ZOMBIE Halloween rifle/pistol shoot (center fire only) will be held at the rifle range on Saturday October 31 beginning at 8:30 AM. The shoot will be limited to members only (minimum age is 18). The match will include both pistols and rifles and require the shooter to move to several stations and shoot at moving targets. Shooters will be timed and scores calculated to determine the winners. In addition to bragging rights for the winners, prizes will be awarded. An outline of the match, including rules and a signup sheet for those interested will be posted at the rifle/pistol range and in the clubhouse. Volunteers will be needed to assist the shooters and to insure that gun safety rules are followed. Thanks to Brandon Shofner for organizing and running this fun shoot.
