President's Corner: Happy New Year to all. In reviewing what transpired last year, the Club had a very good year. For those who were at our annual meeting, this is old news. For those who could not attend, I will give you a brief year end review. Our membership is close to 550 regular, 80 spouses, and 70 junior members. Our Financials were reviewed during the meeting and anyone interested in discussing them, please see myself or Deb Crume. Our total income for 2009 was \$124,588 with expenses of \$115,224. Our net income ended up being \$9,363. Our financials are completed for the year and will be given to our tax accountant the first week in January. Our accomplishments for the year included: club orientation to over 100 new members, 2 CCW classes, continued support of our junior shooting program, safety and shooting classes for the Boy Scout merit badge program, replaced pistol gongs, held our first zombie rifle/pistol shoot, continued monthly military rifle shoots, added additional shooting bales to our archery range, and having our taxes completed early without any late penalties. I personally want to thank our board and all the volunteer members that spent endless hours in equipment repair, mowing, inside clubhouse cleaning, and maintenance to the shooting facility and grounds. I would also like to thank those who have assisted in the shooting programs both rifle and shotgun disciplines. The success of our club rests mainly on the volunteers who donate their time and energies in assisting out where needed.
