VINTAGE SHOOT - Sat, October 28

What makes this a Vintage shoot? Well, for this event the shotguns MUST be pump guns or side-by-sides.

As usual, it's four, 25 target events. An event for each skeet gauge. While we are going to award cash prizes for high overall shooter, it is NOT mandatory for a participant to shoot all 4 gauges. Just shoot the ones you want to. Don't let not having a gun for a particular gauge deter you from shooting. We will have guns that you can use. The cost for each event will be \$10. Of that, \$5 goes to the gauge prize pool, \$2 goes to the HOA pool and the balance will pay for targets.

Pre-registration is not required. We'll simply squad you as you show up. Shooting will start at 8:30 with the following shoot order: 12, 20, 28, .410. We will change squads after 50 targets. When you take the field for your next 50 it will be on the other field. Put simply, if you shoot the 12/20 on the West field, then you'll shoot the 28/.410 on the East field.

RIFLE RANGE ... Please do not shoot 50 caliber BMG rifles on the range. Our gongs are not designed for that strength of fire and several of the new gongs already have holes in them and will require replacement.

ARCHERY RANGE ... Crossbows are allowed on the archery range HOWEVER you must bring your own target. Our archery targets are designed for long arrows with practice points. Crossbow bolts will imbed in the target bale and the bales are being torn up by archers having to 'dig out' their bolts.

ORIENTATION class is held each second Monday at 5:30 in the BSC Clubhouse. All new members are required to attend to receive their membership cards. An open invitation to all club members if you wish to refresh or learn more about the club and safety policies at each of the disciple areas.
