BSC Registered Skeet Shoot:

There will be a registered skeet shoot at the BSC on August 16th. The club will be closed for rifle and pistol shooters until after the event has completed. If there is an open field, skeet shooters will be allowed to shoot on the field not occupied. If you are able to help with this shoot, please call Losson Winkler 333-2583.

Targets and Target Stands Damage:

The metal targets on the pistol range are being damaged **again** by center fire rifles. As the signs state, there should **NOT** be any center fire rifles fired at the metal targets on the pistol range. Also, target stands are being damaged by shotgun use on the rifle range. Shotguns (except with rifled slugs) are not allowed on the

rifle range. If you would like to pattern your shotgun, there is a shotgun pattern board between the clubhouse and the new archery range.

New Archery Range:

There is a new archery range on the southwest side of the Club. Special thanks go out to Randy Hinton, Fred Pocock (owner of the Arrow Shop), and those that assisted them. The range is well designed and is a much needed addition to our club. Please note that these targets are designed for field points only. The use of broad heads is not permitted.

Rifle Pistol Range:

The posted hours for the rifle/pistol range are from noon until 6:00 P.M. on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please complete your shooting and leave the rifle/pistol range by 6:00 P.M. so that it does not interfere with the skeet shooting schedule.

Clubhouse Sale items:

If you have items for sale that are displayed in the Clubhouse, please include your name, phone number, and a price. There is limited space in the clubhouse, so please be considerate of the amount of space you are using. If the shelves designed for holding the gun cases of the shooters become too crowded, we will be forced to discontinue this practice. The trailer used to store clay targets has been moved from the area south of the clubhouse. The new location is up on the hill by the locked gates.
